

## Navigating College Day

Use the following “to do” list to help you make the most of your College Day experience.

Bring your College Day Program Book with you – if you have not received a Program Book stop at the registration table to get one - it is filled with important information about colleges that are represented

Highlight or make a list of the schools you plan to visit

When you enter, pick up a bag to store all your information

Visit the Financial Aid table on the concourse. Financial Aid representatives from two and four year colleges will be available to answer your questions.

Look up! There are signs with college names and locations located above each table.

Talk to various Admissions Representatives – they are there to answer questions about the school, academic majors, activities, campus life etc.

Organize your information! Juniors begin identifying schools you would like to visit in the spring. Seniors begin your college application process.

Meet with your High School Counselor to talk about next steps!
